AMMENDMENT PROPOSAL #1

2.6 Any member of the Executive Committee would not serve on the committee more than two consecutive years. (Amended in AGM-2020, please see Section 5.13)

5.13 (Amendment approved AGM-2020) Chapter 2 Section 2.6 to be amended to: Any member of the Executive Committee would not serve on the committee more than two consecutive years other than some unprecedented circumstances.

Proposed 5.15:

After serving in the Executive Committee for two consecutive years, any member of the Executive Committee or Office Bearer may continue for a third consecutive year, if approved by a vote during AGM. However, no Executive Committee Member or Office Bearer would serve on the committee for more than three consecutive years.
